

UPDATE FROM HARRY GORWOR ON GIFTS OF HOPE SCHOOL

Our school closing program on June 29th was of great success, and I am happy to say that the entire school was marked by tremendous progress. Our first official school year was great!

We had an initial enrollment of 162. One of them passed away in last December. Along the way, 5 others dropped. So we ended the year with 156 students. During our recent closing program, 25 kids graduated from kindergarten to 1st grade. The attendance of parents was so huge; over a hundred and fifty adults were present, rejoicing and praising God for the school. Overall, 95 percent of the students advanced to various grades.

Generally, our teachers performed very well. They will continue with the school for the next school year, except for two who did not measure up professionally, and they had to leave. They have been replaced.

Regarding physical development, we are pleased to report that the fence around the property was completed, thereby enhancing the safety of our property and the kids. We have also painted most part of the building, leaving 4 rooms, which will be done before school begins in September.

We want to thank God for his provision for the school. At the same time, we want to recognize and thank all those who were/are channels of his blessings. Our gratitude goes to CEL, the Board, and all the donors for their immeasurable contributions. We do not have words enough to thank you brothers and sisters. May God bless you richly.
