Greetings Friends,

Hoping and praying that all is well with each of you, your families and your respective church families. Advent blessings upon you all as we await the celebration of the birth of our Savior Jesus.

November

- 1) Joel was able to meet with the Board President and then Board of Directors of CTM Guatemala to consult with them on an extended discernment/planning process around the future of CTM Guatemala. A decision was made to engage a four month discernment process beginning in January and concluding in April. That process in Guatemala will be facilitated by a very good friend of mine and long-time colleague, Ivan Monzón. This time of discernment and planning will produce a three-year strategic plan that will make up the recommendation that the Board of Directors will then put before the General Assembly of the organization in May (founding members of CTM Guatemala of which Marilyn and I are part as well as many from our core Guatemala City network). There is significant wind in the sails right now to get CTM Guatemala back on the track to become a fully accredited Local Leadership Foundation serving Guatemala City. Please pray for this extremely important discernment and planning process over the next four months.
- 2) Three professional baseball players connected to <u>UPI</u> came to Guatemala for three days of clinics and ministry. Different ball players have come 5 years in a row during the months of November/December and that has created a rich set of relationships with young people and their families in the little leagues and baseball federation of Guatemala. The fruit of these trips has been nothing sort of miraculous and seeds were planted for some potential plans next year to deepen the impact of the work in Guatemala with the partnership with UPI.
- 3) Joel then had the opportunity to spend time with great friends from <u>Global Faith Network</u> who came down to spend three days of interaction with select ministry leaders from the grassroots network of Guatemalan ministry leaders that we as a family have served here in Guatemala City. The time we had from November 13 15 dedicated to fellowship, mentoring, discussing sustainable funding practices was very fruitful.
- 4) On November 16, Joel had the chance to be in Managua, Nicaragua visiting with our UTC Training Hub partner The Nehemiah Center for Community Transformation. The Nehemiah Center celebrated its 20th anniversary. I spent the weekend there engaging and encouraging our Nicaraguan friends before speaking to the Nehemiah Center team on Monday morning. We were able to officially sign an MOU with the Nicaraguan team making Managua our 14th city of the expanding Urban Training Collaborative.

On A Personal Note: Thanksgiving for us this year was one that brought great challenges and some sadness. Marilyn's grandfather, Confesor Adames, passed away in Puerto Rico the Tuesday before Thanksgiving and just 3 days short of his 99th birthday. We had been able to secure very economical flights for Marilyn, Sofia and I to fly to Puerto Rico to support Marilyn's mother who had been his chief caretaker especially the past 3-4 months of his rapidly declining health. We arrived just two days prior to his passing and thus Marilyn was able to spend some precious moments with her grandfather just before his entrance into the Lord's presence. We celebrate his life of 99 years and the incredible legacy he left in Puerto Rico and on his entire family and community. Marilyn's mother flew back to Florida with us and is staying two weeks with us for a much needed and deserved time of rest and respite.

December

Joel will be in Dallas 3 days this week planning with the Mission Innovation Team and other targeted leaders of Resonate Global Mission. For those of you not part of the Christian Reformed Church, Resonate Global Mission is the mission agency of the Christian Reformed Church in North America and Joel has had the privilege of serving the agency as a member of the Mission Innovation Team. For the past 4 months, Resonate has been engaged in an extensive planning/evaluation process to give direction for the future of the mission agency. There has been 6 Working Groups organized around core strategic outcomes that the agency has been committed to live into. Joel has been able to serve as a co-facilitator for one of those Working Groups. The next three days (Dec. 9-11) will be crucial as the tracks for many years of future ministry for the Christian Reformed Church and a myriad of partner organizations, etc. will be laid out during this time together in Dallas. Your prayers are deeply appreciated.

Finally, the ground work is being laid out for an outstanding opportunity for young adults this coming Summer. The attached flyer has all the details and the application deadline is being extended to January 20th. Please be in prayer for this exciting pilot Central American vision trip which hopefully will become an annual vision trip pending the evaluation from the pilot year. At this point, Joel hopes to be present in the traveling portion of the trip but regardless of whether it works for him to physically go, both Joel and Marilyn will be instrumental in the planning of the details for the trip once participants have been secured.
